Reminders

They correspond with the color bin that your child puts their folder in every day, and it makes it much easier for them to know where things go-and we're practicing colors and sorting at the same time!
- Please try to make sure that your child is not in "slip on" shoes. We have a lot of stairs to contend with! Also, If your child is in a dress, please make sure that there are shorts or leggings underneath. Thank You!
- Our website is generally kept updated with the big event dates, so feel free to check it often, or refer to it if you forget a date, or address for field trips ect, or the monthly newsletter.

Pick Up/Drop Off Line:

If the weather is bad when you arrive, please pull under the overhang if possible, and we will use door 1 for that day. Otherwise, please pull as close as possible to the fireside door, and be sure that you are free of distractions and alert as teachers begin bringing children to cars. This ensures the safety of children and staff, and helps us get everyone out in as timely a manner as possible. There is a state law that prohibits the use of cell phones while operating a vehicle in a school zone area, unless it is in "hands free" voice activated mode. Another reminder that children must be in a weight appropriate carseat and not in the front seat of the vehicle before they leave the parking lot, and MUST BE BUCKLED IN. Remember that your children are watching, and your good example helps them learn respect for rules and regulations.
