If you are uncertain about next year in any way, please talk to your child's teacher! This is a great time to get their thoughts and give them yours, to ensure that we are all working together to do what's best for you and your child. Please keep in mind, for those old enough to consider going to Kindergarten, that when your Teacher considers Kindergarten readiness, they will consider a myriad of different things, and any opinions, observations or suggestions given by our staff come from a deep desire to see your child succeed! We are passionate about seeing our students enter Kindergarten with confidence and a joy for learning, which will set them up for a positive learning experience throughout the rest of their school years.

- **Medical forms:** Please make sure that you are checking your child's medical statement, and planning ahead. Our teachers do their best to send reminders a month in advance, however, the Doctor's office usually requires quite a few months at least. Per the state, for us to be able to keep your child enrolled, they must have a medical statement that is current up to one year. This means that we look at the date of your child's last exam-not their birthdate, or the date the Dr. signed the form. The date of their last exam cannot be more than one year from the current date, or they cannot attend school until it is renewed. Please text your teacher if you are unsure when yours expires. Thank you for your help in keeping us in compliance with the State rules.
