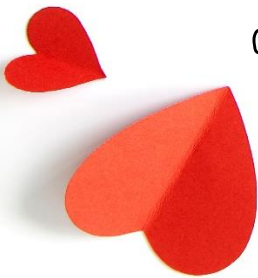
Medical forms: Please make sure that you are checking your child's medical statement, and planning ahead. Our teachers do their best to send reminders a month in advance, however, the Doctor's office usually requires quite a few months at least. Per the state, for us to be able to keep your child enrolled, they must have a medical statement that is current up to one year. This means that we look at the date of your child's last exam—not their birthdate, or the date the Dr. signed the form. The date of their last exam cannot be more than one year from the current date, or they cannot attend school until it is renewed. Please text your teacher if you are unsure when yours expires. Thank you for your help in keeping us in compliance with the State rules.
