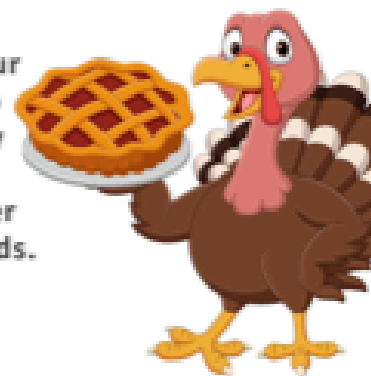
Reminders and Announcements

The Canton Repository recently shared this small article about reading with your children that we wanted to share.

"Everyone is busy and it often seems impossible to squeeze one more thing into the day. That's a fact, but here's another one: unless we connect with our children several times a day, there is a strong risk that we will not know who our children are, what they need, or how to help them grow. One simple way to spend time with your children is to read together. Twenty minutes of reading aloud to your child every day will accomplish more than you can ever measure. No matter how hectic your day, make time to connect with your kids. They're counting on you."
